
## Using Deep Links to access Westlaw NZ

Westlaw NZ supports deep linking to most parts of the site. The Link Builder icon  can be seen on the **Table of Contents** and all **Documents** and should be used where available.

### How to create a Deep Link

To create a link:

- Locate the Content Type, Practice Area, Jurisdiction, Product, Chapter, Sub Chapter, Classification, Topic or Document you want to link to
- Click on the Link Builder icon 
- A pop up box will appear listing the Deep Link URL, copy the URL

The URL can now be inserted into intranets, web browser favourites, emails, newsletters, internal software and systems, anywhere you choose.

To deep link to other parts of the site that do not have the Link Builder icon (i.e My Folders), go to the applicable page and then copy the URL in the browser address bar.

### Link Locations

Different Links will load different parts of the site, depending on what they are. See below for the rules applied to deep linking.

- Products - will load the Advanced Search Form for that Product.
- Content Types - will load the Advanced Search Form for that Content Type.
- Practice Areas or Jurisdictions - will load the Basic Search Form for the Practice Area or Jurisdiction.
- Chapters, Classifications, Parts and Topics within products - will load the browse view with all documents listed in the right hand pane.
- Documents - will load the document.
